

Master of Arts in Ministry

Purpose

The Stark College and Seminary Master of Arts in Ministry is a forty-four hour degree designed with two main goals in mind: 1) To prepare students to enter vocational ministry in any ministry capacity; 2) To enable students who desire to do so to transfer their hours and complete a Master of Divinity degree with select seminaries without loss of credit hours.
