

Undergraduate Chapel Requirements
South Texas School of Christian Studies
Corpus Christi, TX

Chapel is an important component of the student's spiritual formation. It serves to provide the student with a weekly time to worship and focus upon the One who has called them to study here. To encourage students to engage in chapel, SCS undergraduate programs have a chapel requirement. Students receive a credit for each chapel or its equivalent within which they participate.

To fulfill the chapel requirement, each student must earn 20 chapel credits prior to graduation. Credits may be earned in several ways:

1. Chapel attendance Thursday chapel – mid day – 1 credit each
NOTE: Clean up group at chapel – 2 credits, if you sign up for the group and fulfill your commitment with at least 12 chapels
2. Community service
3 approved service forums – 1 chapel credit for each hour volunteered
 - i. After school program at Crossbridge Fellowship
 - ii. First Baptist Church of Corpus Christi
 1. Assist with Food Pantry
 2. Assist with GED program
 - iii. Christian Women's Job Corps
3. Special Events – 1 credit for each hour or event if less than an hour
 - a. Self Symposium
 - b. iYC
 - c. Other training or worship events, including periodic prayer chapels

For community service or special events, the student may pick up a chapel credit request form from the Office of Student Affairs or download the form from the school website under the section "Chapel." Service or attendance must be verified by the signature of the director of the program or event or his or her designated representative.

Students graduating during 2015 may have the chapel requirement
